Matt Mead and Wyoming Veterans Commission Chairman Keith Davidson request the pleasure of your attendance for the ceremony. "The partnership and dedication among many state agencies, veterans' organizations, and private donors is what made this memorial possible." The event will be held on the state museum grounds, north of the building. In case of inclement weather, the event will be held in the museum's lobby.
