GENERAL ORDERS ~ 2015-2016 SERIES ~ #12 ~ June 2016

Attention: All Post Adjutants are reminded to read the General Orders at your next Post meeting and post them in your Post Home or other meeting place.

Section 222: Delegates, District Convention & Meetings, Department and National Convention (b) explains the method of electing Delegates in regards to the afore mentioned conventions, Commanders are reminded to follow these instructions. This section also covers the “Fee” paid to National to register your Post for the National Convention, Post fee is \$25 (that entitles one delegate) and additional members are \$10 each. It doesn’t matter if anyone attends or not, this is registering the Post so the State Commander can vote the full strength of the Department. Other members registered that do attend will receive the Convention packet and be allowed to vote as well.

This must be done each year! If anyone needs to invoice contact me and I’ll get you another copy, each post was mailed the invoice several weeks ago.

Section 216: The Adjutant will have in their possession Proof of Eligibility for all elected or appointed officers, prior to installation, properly reviewed by the Commander, Adjutant and Quartermaster. There is no requirement or reason for any other proof of eligibility of any other non-officers to be kept by the Adjutant or at the post.
